

TOUR ITINERARY

Day One

Once everyone has been picked up from the designated points we will continue to check in at Hull at approximately 7pm for our overnight sailing. Once you have checked into your cabin you will have time at leisure to use the facilities onboard.

(An overnight bag will be required so your main case can be left on the coach)

Day Two

After arriving in Rotterdam we will disembark at 9am. We will continue to Leiden and Utrecht for free time to explore and have lunch.

We will then journey to Nunspeet later this afternoon, checking into your room at the Dennenhoeve hotel, arriving in time for your included three-course evening meal.

Day Three

After breakfast, we include a full-day excursion to Keukenhof Gardens. Before arriving at the gardens you will join our Lakes and Windmills Cruise.

This delightful tour offers a taste of traditional Dutch life as we cruise past picturesque natural scenery including tulip fields in glorious bloom and picture-perfect windmills and water mills.

Sit back and relax as a friendly Dutch vessel gently cruises the lakes of the Kagerplassen, passing the scenic village of Kaagdorp on Kaag Island

Upon arrival at Keukenhof Gardens, the remainder of the day is at leisure.

Perhaps take a stroll through the expansive exhibition area and discover one of Europe's largest fountains, plus an exciting labyrinth, an historic garden and a number of workshops.

You can even order flower bulbs for your garden back home – a great gift idea. In addition to the millions of blooming flower bulbs and fantastic flower shows, Keukenhof has the largest sculpture garden in the Netherlands and is the most photographed spot in the world.

Day Four

After breakfast, join your included Grand Holland tour. This tour will take you to discover Amsterdam with its cobbled streets, glorious architecture and famous canals, before continuing to the pretty fishing village of Volendam, with its brightly painted houses. We will also visit a clog maker and traditional Dutch Cheese Maker. We will return to the hotel this evening, in time for your included evening meal.

Day Five

After breakfast, it's time to bid farewell to our friendly hosts, and re-join the coach for an en-route visit to the Netherlands Open Air Museum in Arnhem.

In a beautiful, wooded park on the outskirts of Arnhem lies a very special museum. Step into more than 80 historic houses, farmhouses and mills, and spend a day discovering how ordinary Dutch people have lived over the last few hundred years. Meet friendly farmers, the wheelwright, the blacksmith, the fisherman and the miller. As they work, they will paint you a colourful picture of their lives. You may even get the chance to roll up your sleeves yourself!

Later this afternoon we will continue to Hull for the overnight crossing back to the UK. Again, Once you have checked into your cabin you will have time at leisure to use the facilities onboard.
